#### Sub: - Annual School Calendar for the session 2019-20.

The Education department of NDMC has planned its academic activities in the form of Annual Calendar for the session 2019 20. The annual calendar has been prepared to ensure focused and timely work in every school. It will certainly guide and help in effective planning of the work to be done on priority. Needless to say the annual calendar must be discussed in detail amongst the teachers with an aim to improve overall performance of the students.

 All HOS of NDMC, NDMC Aided & Navyug Schools shall ensure the proper implementation of the following instructions –

 The Annual Calendar must be followed in all seriousness. Each HOS will maintain a separate register in which date wise brief report must be written by the concern teacher in-charge etc.

ii. All HOS will maintain a supervision diary and observe at least one lesson every day. Teachers' Diary including that of Librarian, Yoga, Music, Sports teachers etc. must be checked regularly and to be used as an effective tool to improve class room teaching.

III. Principals/HOS, Vice - Principals and Headmistresses will take classes as per the earlier direction. The same must be reflected in the school time table.

iv. Time table must be prepared as per the direction given earlier. There must be a time table for preprimary and primary classes as well.

v. The HOS is expected to regularly monitor the class wise learning outcomes as specified by NCERT/SCERT. HOS must conduct meetings specifically to guide the teachers about quality teaching during 2.00 P.M. to 2.30 P.M. as intimated earlier.

Project UNNATI must become the part of the School System. Low achievers in all the classes must be identified from the very beginning and concrete time bound steps must be taken from the very beginning of the session including specific time to improve minimum level of learning. Separate instructions are issued for Project Unnati for 2019-20.

vi. Monitoring of practical and other subject related activities to be done regularly and effectively. School Library, Labs etc. must be utilized effectively.

vii. Zero period to be treated as an important part of the school Time - Table and must be used judiciously to improve/achieve learning outcomes appropriate to the class and age of the child.

viii. It must be ensured that the teachers write detailed report after attending any workshop/seminar and submit one copy to the HOS to be kept in the separate file. One copy must be attached with the teacher Diary. Similarly each visit/activity of the students must be planned in relation to their learning (plan a questionnaire before any visit, writing the report after the visit/activity, Preparing a bulletin board etc.

ix. Mid-day meal should be distributed in available recess period of 30 minutes.

x. 40 % of the syllabus of the Board going classes to be completed before the summer vacations and whole syllabus to be completed by 30<sup>th</sup> November.

xi. Zero tolerance on safety and security of students to be observed.

xii. All efforts must be made to ensure clean, safe and vibrant learning environment in the school. Attention must be paid to save water and electricity.

**3.** Annual School Calendar 2019-20 containing month wise activity is attached herewith. The activities in the calendar are indicative and are not limited. HOS/class teacher may organize any event if it is in the interest of the academic environment of the school. HOS must however ensure that whenever an activity is planned a report must be uploaded on whatapp group with a copy to the NDMC Education Head quarter.
