Brief History of the Subject/Project:	Disposal of Old & Unserviceable Metal Scraps, Caps/Starters/Igniters/Chokes etc, received from various user divisions in the form of Metal Scraps, Caps/Starters/Igniters/Chokes etc. For disposal of above items, the condemnation sub-committee recommended for disposal at the total computed Reserve Price of Rs.8,13,705/- (with item wise STA condition, as applicable) by way of e-auction through MSTC.
4.	Detailed Proposal on the Subject/Project:	Condemnation Sub-Committee constituted for fixing Reserve Price for disposal of Old & Unserviceable material, inspected the old material at Stores-II, Vidyut Bhawan and recommended that Old & Unserviceable material such as Iron Scrap (Qty-6246.640 Kg), Brass Scrap (Qty: 2Kg), Copper Scrap (Qty: 76 Kg), Aluminium Scrap (Qty: 2571.900 Kg), Old Burnt Chokes (Qty: 1999 Nos.), Caps & Starters (Qty: 4818 Nos.), Igniters (Qty:2251 Nos.) & Lead Scrap (Qty: 101.200 Kg), are required to be disposed off through MSTC by way of e-auction, at the total computed Reserve Price of Rs.8,13,705/- (with item wise STA condition as applicable).
5.	Financial Implication of the proposed Project/Subject:	Credit of Rs.8,13,705/- (with item wise STA condition, as applicable)
