

2. **Eligibility Criteria for Radiologist (Radiology):**
 - 1) MD/DNB/DMRD in Radiology in the concerned speciality from a Recognized University/Institution in the concerned subject and valid registration with Delhi Medical Council.
3. **Appointment & Tenure:** Initially 02 hours/six days a week for a period of 01 year subject to satisfactory performance.



4. **Experience:** Minimum three years experience in the concerned speciality (Radiologist) after obtaining Post-Graduate Degree or Five years experience after obtaining the Post-Graduate Diploma.

Specialist retired from Govt. hospitals may also apply.

5. **Emoluments per month:** Rs. 2500/- for two hours per day for six days a week.
6. **Age** no bar.

Replies of the observations to Personnel Department are as follows:-

1. Radiologists are qualified to read the x-rays, MRI & CT Scan as well as do the ultrasounds whereas ultrasonologist can only do the ultrasounds. The basic used for PMH is that of an ultrasonologist and for CPH is of Radiologist hence the terms have been used interchangeably as Radiologist can be used at both the places. Wherever ultrasonologist is mentioned, it is requested that it may be amended to the term Radiologist. The qualification of the Radiologist is MD/DMRD/DNB in Radiology.
2. Informally, Radiologists were asked to join and three radiologist had also sent there Curriculum Vitae too, but, due to the lack of timely affirmation from the Department, they joined elsewhere and later declined the offer.
3. The proposal envisages an advertisement through leading Newspapers and NDMC website portal as per the existing RRs in the Health Establishment.

Yes, the proposed higher remuneration may result into similar demands from the existing or future part time specialists, as these remunerations are being offered the time of hiring of visiting consultants since 2014. It has also been seen that there is a higher attrition rate of part time radiologist who joined the Medical Services Department in the past.
